APA Formatting Style:

APA formatting styles are used for the formatting of scholarly articles, journals, and books. It is commonly used for social and behavioral sciences disciplines. When you are assigned to write a research paper according to APA format, you need to choose the topic according to the field of behavioral and social sciences. You may get plenty of **research paper topics**, but you need to select the best topic that perfectly suits your requirements. Here are the formatting specifications of the APA formatting style.

- **Paper Size:** The standard paper size for APA is 8.5 x 11" (8.5 inches by 11 inches).
- **Paper Margin:** A margin of 1" (one inch) on all sides of the paper.
- **Font Style:** Times New Roman, Arial, or Calibri

- **End of Line:** Insert a space after each line unless your teacher asks you to insert two spaces.
- **Paragraph Indentation:** 5-7 spaces or a tab
- **Page Number:** Appears on the upper right corner of every page, 1/2' from the top.
- **Title Page:** It contains the running head, paper title, student name, [write my essay for me](#), instructor name, and institute name.
- **Headings:** Title case and left-aligned
- **In-Text Citation:** The author/date method is used, which means the author's last name and publication date appear in the reference list, i.e. (kate, 2020).

MLA Formatting Style:

The other common style is the MLA formatting style. Below you can find its specifications. However, while following the guidelines, you need to make sure that you have fulfilled the word count requirement. Do not underwrite or overwrite. You can use a **words counter for essays** to keep an eye on the paper's word count.

- **Paper Size:** A4 or 8.5 x 11" (8.5 inches by 11 inches).
- **Paper Margin:** 1" on all sides
- **Font Style:** Times New Roman
- **Font Size:** 12 pt
- **Spacing:** Double spaced

- **Page Number:** Appears on the upper right corner of every page, 1/2' from the top.
- **Title Page:** It contains the running head, paper title, student name, course name, instructor name, and date.
- **Headings:** Title case and left-aligned
- **In-Text Citation:** The author/page method is used, which means the author's last name and page number [essay writing service](#) in the reference list, i.e. (Johnson 259).
