

Guidelines for Oral Presentation

ASIASENSE 2021 will be held as a virtual conference on the Zoom platform and not Webex as previously mentioned. We request all speakers, named Presenters, to give their talk live in the allotted time specified in the technical program.

However, to cope with possible connectivity issues and to allow video replay for people who were unable to attend, each speaker is also requested to record and submit a YouTube link of pre-recorded presentation. However, the author must be online to answer questions after the talk.

PRESENTERS (ORAL PRESENTATION) – LIVE ZOOM PRESENTATION

- Opportunity to do a Live Presentation at the Conference.
- Each Presenter will get 10 Minutes for their Presentation and 05 Minutes for Q&A Session.
- Please indicate your abstract ID instead of your name upon joining as a participant in the virtual AsiaSense 2021
- You will have to share your screen and advance your slides.
- Presenter's consent for the online event is required. Kindly complete the consent form by **Thursday 14th October 2021** via <https://bit.ly/AsiaSense2021OralPresentation>.

PRESENTERS (ORAL PRESENTATION) – PRE-RECORDED VIDEO OPTION

- This Option is for the Presenter who would have a concern with internet connection during the conference.
- The Presenter can record the 10 Minutes Video Presentation, upload the video on YouTube and share the link with us. (The Video should be 10 minutes or less). You may also set the privacy/visibility setting to Private and Share Privately with sensor.malaysia@gmail.com.
- The Organizing Committee will play the YouTube Video in your Presentation Slot .
- You should be present during your slot for the Q&A Session (05 Minutes Q&A).
- Please indicate your abstract ID instead of your name upon joining as a participant in the virtual AsiaSense 2021
- Presenter's consent for the online event is required. Kindly complete the consent form and provide YouTube Link of Pre-recorded Oral Presentations by **Thursday 14th October 2021** via <https://bit.ly/AsiaSense2021OralPresentation>.

ADDITIONAL INSTRUCTIONS FOR VIDEO RECORDING

Videos should contain a prominent view of the presentation slides along with audio of the spoken presentation. Optionally videos may contain a shot of the speaker's head for increased engagement. Many presentation softwares allows recording audio and video directly in the application and can export appropriate video files. Please see the notes below for detailed instructions for PowerPoint. You may also use other applications or software i.e Keynote or Canva.
