

Guidelines for Virtual Poster Presentation

Due to the virtual nature of the conference, we are only accepting Electronic Posters (E-Posters) in pdf format. E-Poster will be played as a slideshow during the conference without audio. Printed posters or photographs of printed posters will NOT be accepted.

- Poster Submission Deadline: **14 October 2021**
- Poster Submission Platform: Upload your pdf E-posters on any cloud storage (ie dropbox, google drive, sharepoint) and share your file by providing an accessible link that is downloadable.
- Presenter's consent for the online event is required. Kindly complete the consent form and provide downloadable E-poster link by **14th October 2021** via <https://bit.ly/AsiaSense2021PosterPresentation>.

The poster should be a clear visual presentation of your submitted abstract and should meet the following criteria:

TITLE OF THE POSTER

- It is recommended to keep the Title of the poster the same as in the submitted abstract. A slight modification that does not change the idea of the abstract is also allowed.

POSTER SIZE & FORMAT

- Dimensions: 48" wide x 36" tall landscape format
- File format: you may create your poster using Powerpoint or any application but your final completed poster has to be in a pdf format.
- Maximum slides – 5 slides
- The poster file size may not exceed 10MB.
- Font: Arial, Calibri, Times Roman

POSTER CREATION

You can use PowerPoint to make your poster. Getting Started instructions are below.

PowerPoint :

1. In PowerPoint, begin by creating a slide PowerPoint presentation - choose a blank slide. (The entire poster must be contained in a maximum of 5 slides).
2. Adjust the slide size to make the poster dimensions a maximum of 48" x 36".
3. Save your poster as a .pptx file while you are working on it.
4. Save the file as .pdf
5. The poster file size may not exceed 10MB.

6. Upload your pdf file on cloud sharing platform (ie google drive/dropbox/SharePoint)

7. Get the shareable link.

Author affiliation

- Authors' complete names and affiliations should be written under the Title of the poster.

Content of the Poster

- Make sure that the specific sections (such as the background, methods, results, and conclusions) are easily located in the poster.
- Try to keep the text easy to read and concise. The poster should have a clear message, a logical layout and be easy to comprehend.
- Avoid the use of whole sentences and instead use short text in bullet point format.
- Avoid using watermarks that may detract from the readability of your poster.

Illustrations

- Illustrations are the most important part of the poster and will attract the most attention. Colourful charts and graphs are the easiest to read. Explanatory illustrations should be used instead of text whenever possible.
- Use only static images and do not embed any videos or animation in your poster.
- Try to utilize the space on your poster as creatively as possible to attract the audience and make sure that the images are easy to understand.

BEST POSTER AWARDS

- 3 best posters will be awarded.
- Posters will be evaluated based on the following three parameters; those are Presentation Clarity of the poster , Research Quality and Layout/Design.
