Potential topics of interest from the perspective of Financial Literacy include, but are not limited to:

- Analysis of post pandemic financial inclusion issues and challenges
- Effectiveness of policies and programmes, including their measurement
- Digital financial literacy and consumer protection
- Financial fraud and scams
- Financial inclusion and social protection
- Consumer financial behavior
- Behavioural insights for the design of financial products
- Policy design and implementation
- Vulnerable groups, e.g., self – employed (including gig workers, MSMEs), youth and others.
- Understanding financial needs at different life stages
- The application of behavioural insights to influence financial behavior
- Harnessing financial literacy to enhance retirement well-being

AWARD AND POSTER PRESENTATION

The papers will be reviewed by a Scientific Committee panel and qualified paper(s) will be presented during the symposium. Selected papers will be invited for poster exhibition at the conference with a certificate of recognition.

The Conference Organizer will confer e-Certificate/s for Best Paper Award to qualified paper(s) as recommended by the Scientific Committee's panel.

- Three (3) Best Paper will receive RM1,000 cash prize for each paper.
